Rochelle Feinstein

Painterly joie de vivre and political malaise face off in Feinstein's new show, which is ti-tled "Who Cares." Spoiler alert: apathy loses. "Off Color," a big square canvas featuring brightly colored trapezoids in pinwheel for-mation, greets visitors with a wow at the door. In other works, Feinstein tempers ebullience with encroaching darkness. A white curtain is emblazoned with words and phrases lifted from political news coverage, a tempest of lan-guage in the artist's handwriting. In the scene-stealing "H(e)art Island," a misty gray en-croaches on a maplike abstraction, embellished with a hand-sewn heart shape. Named for Hart Island, the historic New York location of a now defunct psychiatric hospital and a potter's field, it's a melancholic tribute to the city's forgot-ten. Through May 14.
